Administrative Reports:

- **Policy Review** We will be working on policies that need to be updated, but Ann needs to check with the Diocese on wording for some of the policies. Ann handed out the # 500 policies. We will review these first starting with the next board meeting.
- State Reports Ann has completed several State and Diocesan reports including Certified Enrollment, BEDS, (Basic Educational Data System), & Data Analysis. The BEDS collects information on our calendar, English language learners, students ethnicity, and staff licensing and trainings, Our calendar has 1122 scheduled student hours. We are required to have a minimum of 1080. Certified enrollment collects data on the number of students, the school districts our students are in, race/ethnicity, number of students receiving Education Savings Accounts, number of students on free & reduced lunch.
- **CIM** Critical Incident Mapping will be completed on Nov. 1. This is an opportunity, offered by the State at no cost to us, for a digital map to be made of our school rooms, windows, doors, fire extinguishers, etc. When completed, the digital map will be available to law enforcement and emergency management systems.
